The 215,000 SF two phase project consisted of 504 bedrooms as well as a community building and outdoor amenity area.

Sustainability was a key element in the design and construction of this project. The apartments feature low-flow Kohler faucets and showerheads, and all lighting fixtures and bulbs are compact fluorescent lights. Other sustainable features include water efficient landscaping, public transportation access and the use of low-emitting materials.

Additionally, 95% of all waste on the construction site was diverted from a landfill through diligent sorting, separating and recycling or salvaging every piece of metal, plastic, wood, debris and more.

As a result of the dedication to sustainability, the first phase of the project received LEED certification in 2012 and the second phase of the project received its LEED certification in 2014.
